AIM

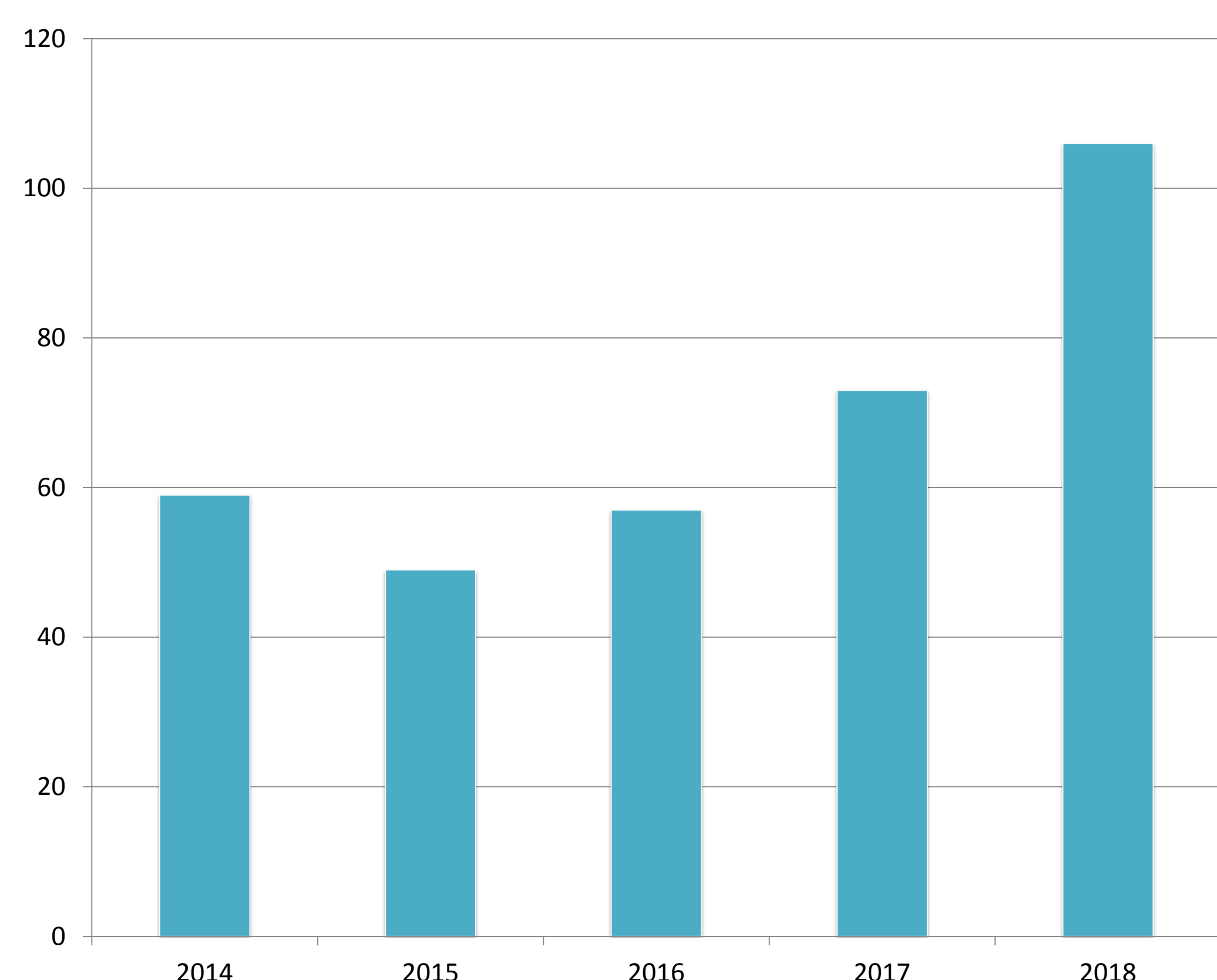
Few studies in recent years have described the epidemiological profile of sexual assault victims in Spain. This descriptive study shows the characteristics of the sexual assault victims attended by SAMUR-Protección Civil in Madrid, Spain.

METHOD

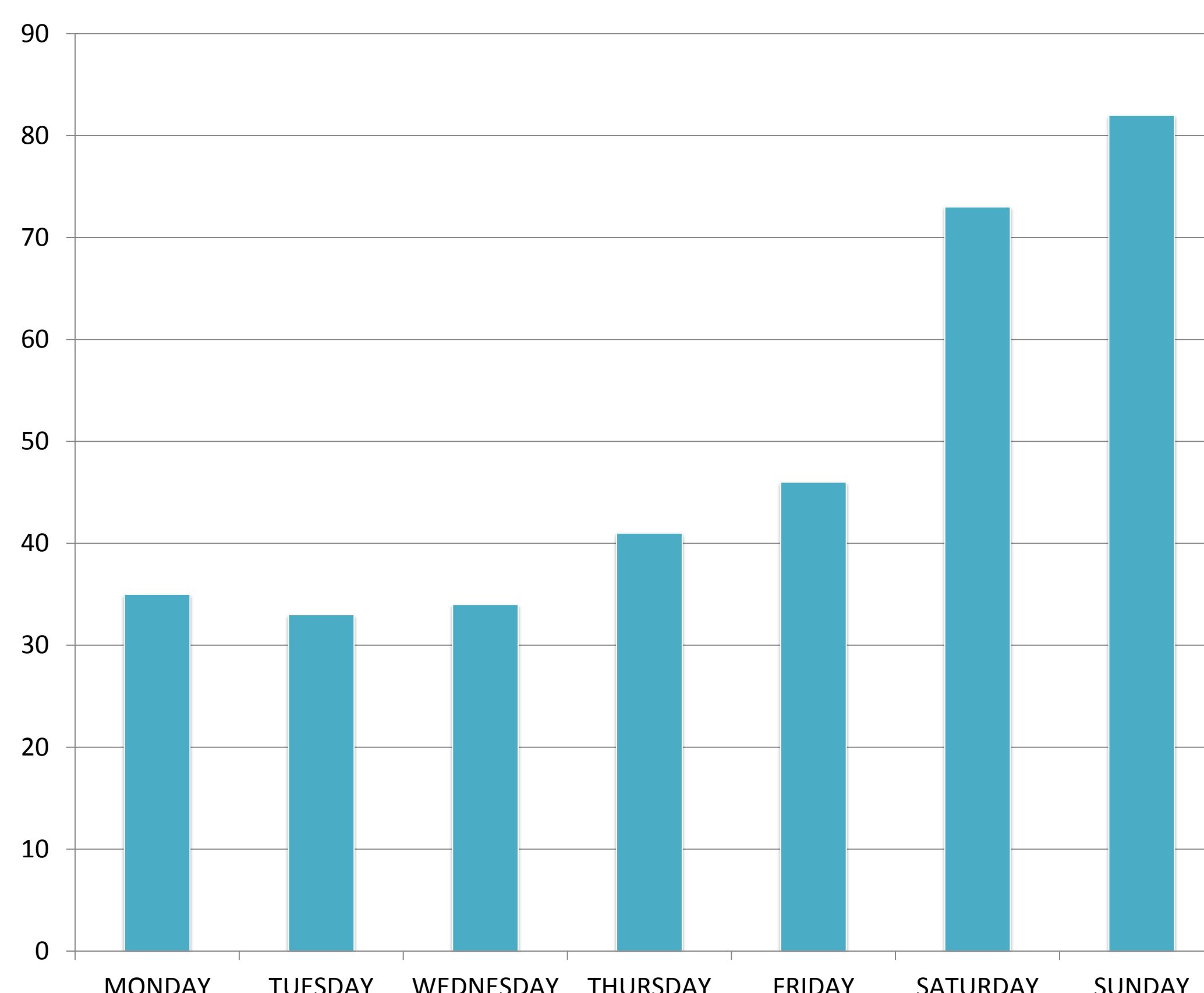
A retrospective observational review of all sexual assault victims (N=342) attended by SAMUR-Protección Civil was conducted. The review includes the last five years, from the 1st of January of 2014 to the 31st of December of 2018. Gender and age data of the victims were collected, as well as time slot day and month when aggressions were committed.

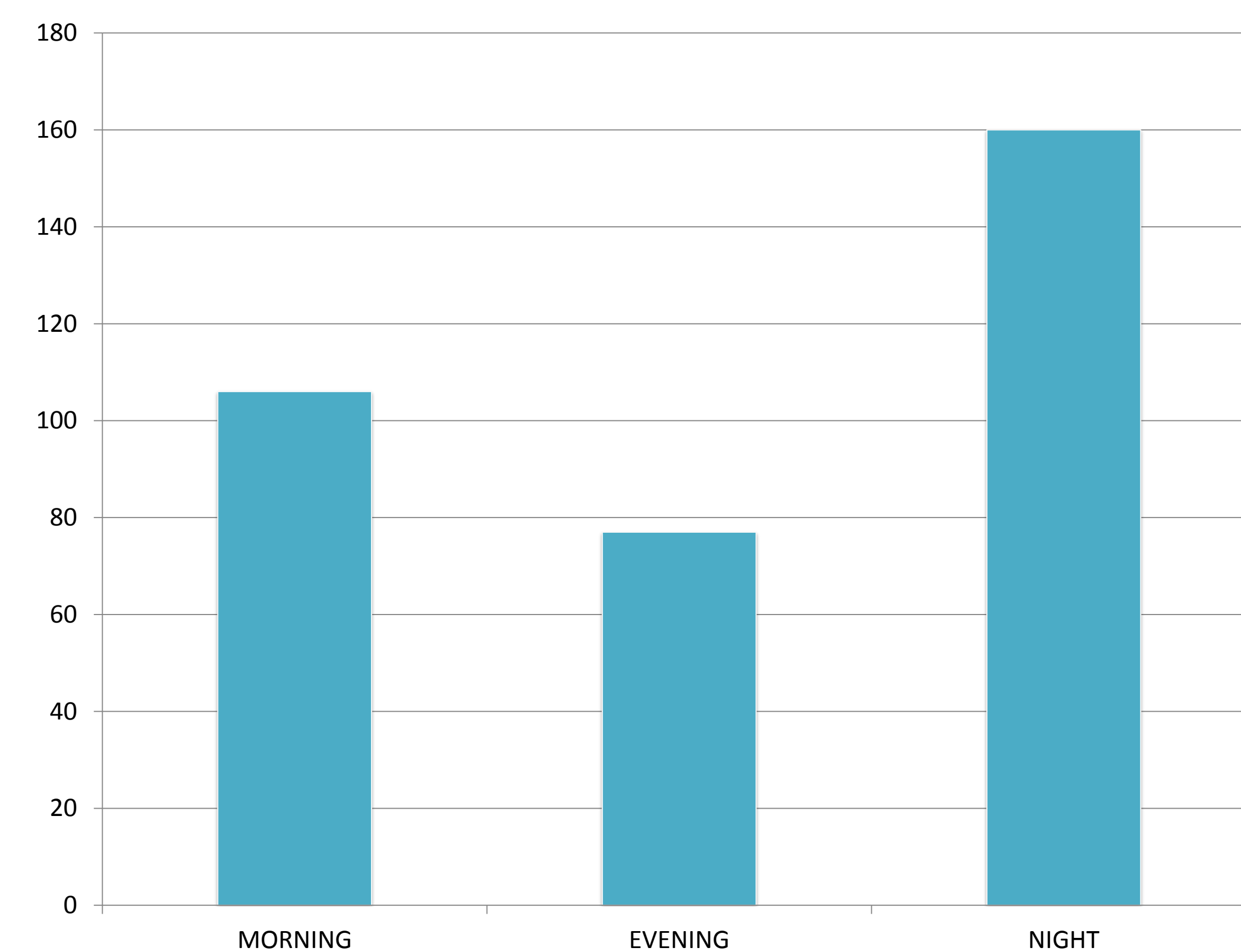
TOTAL SEXUAL ASSAULTS



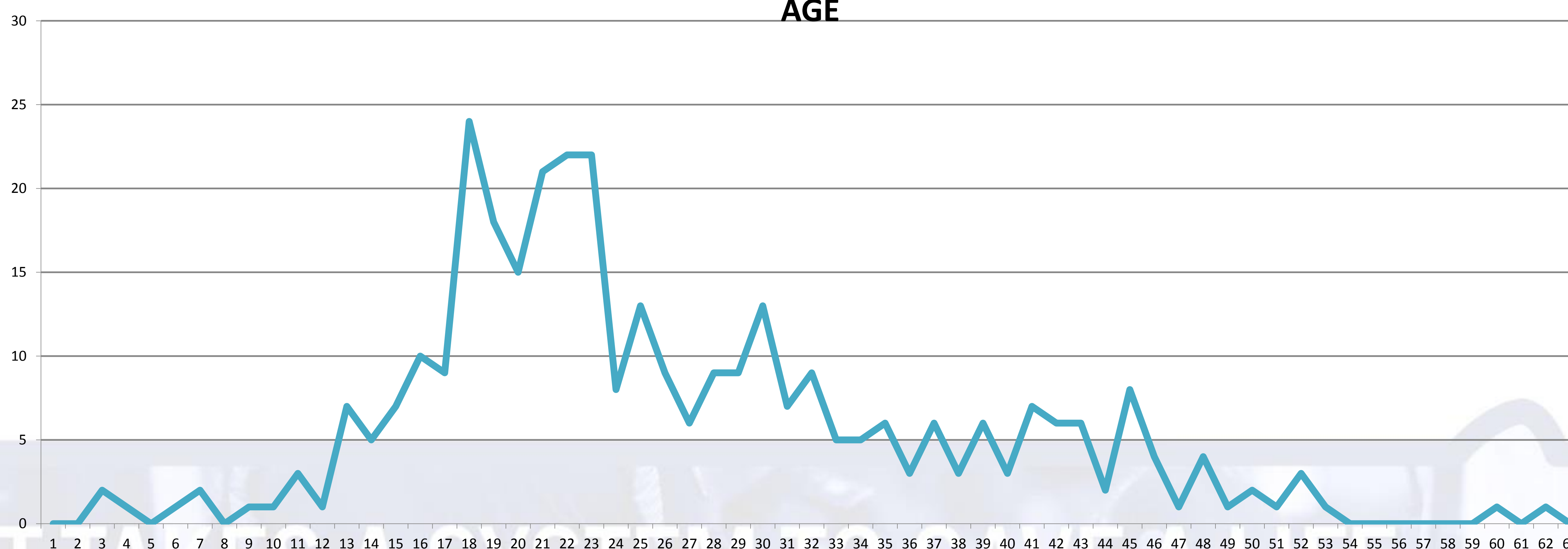
DAY OF THE WEEK



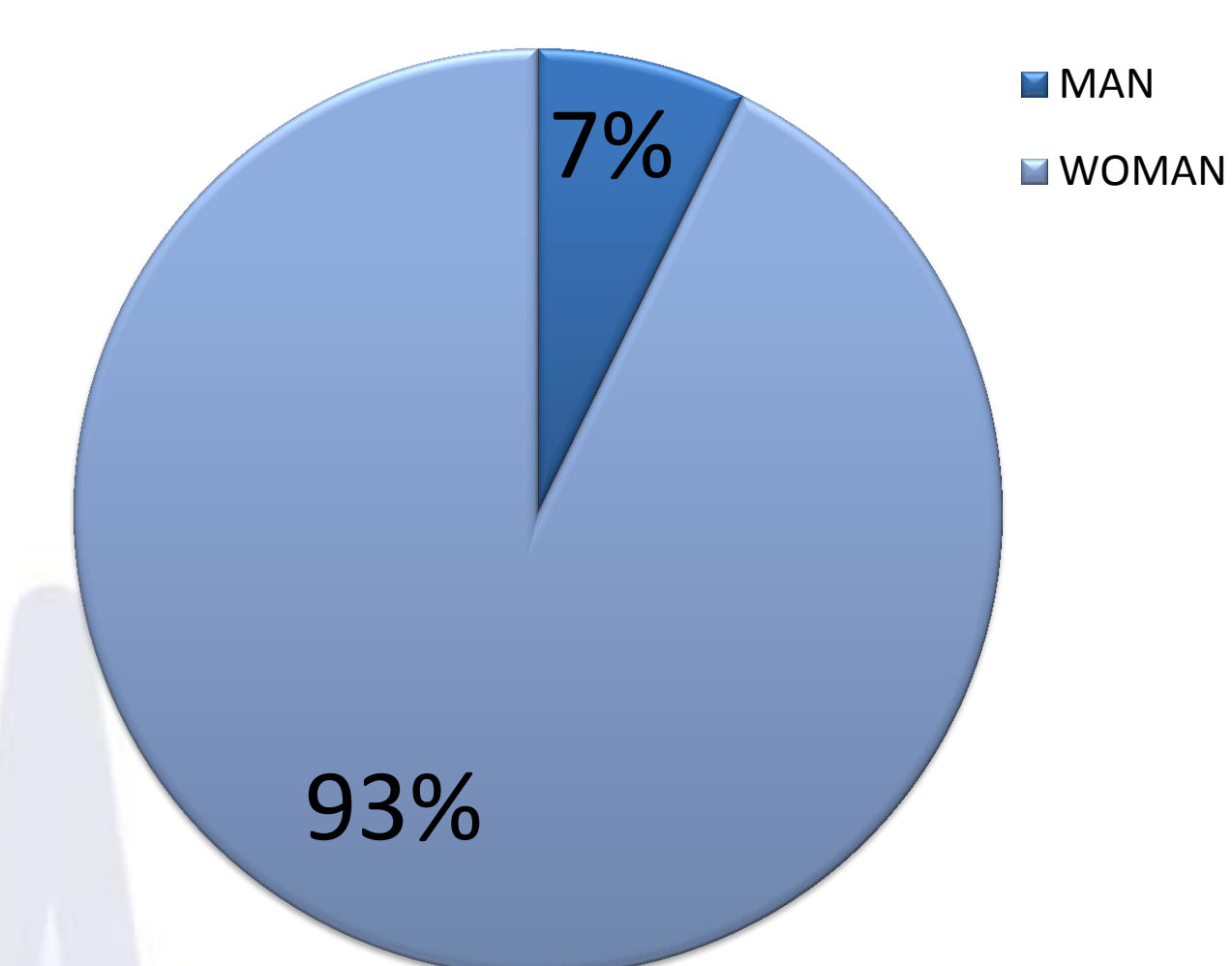
MOMENT OF THE DAY



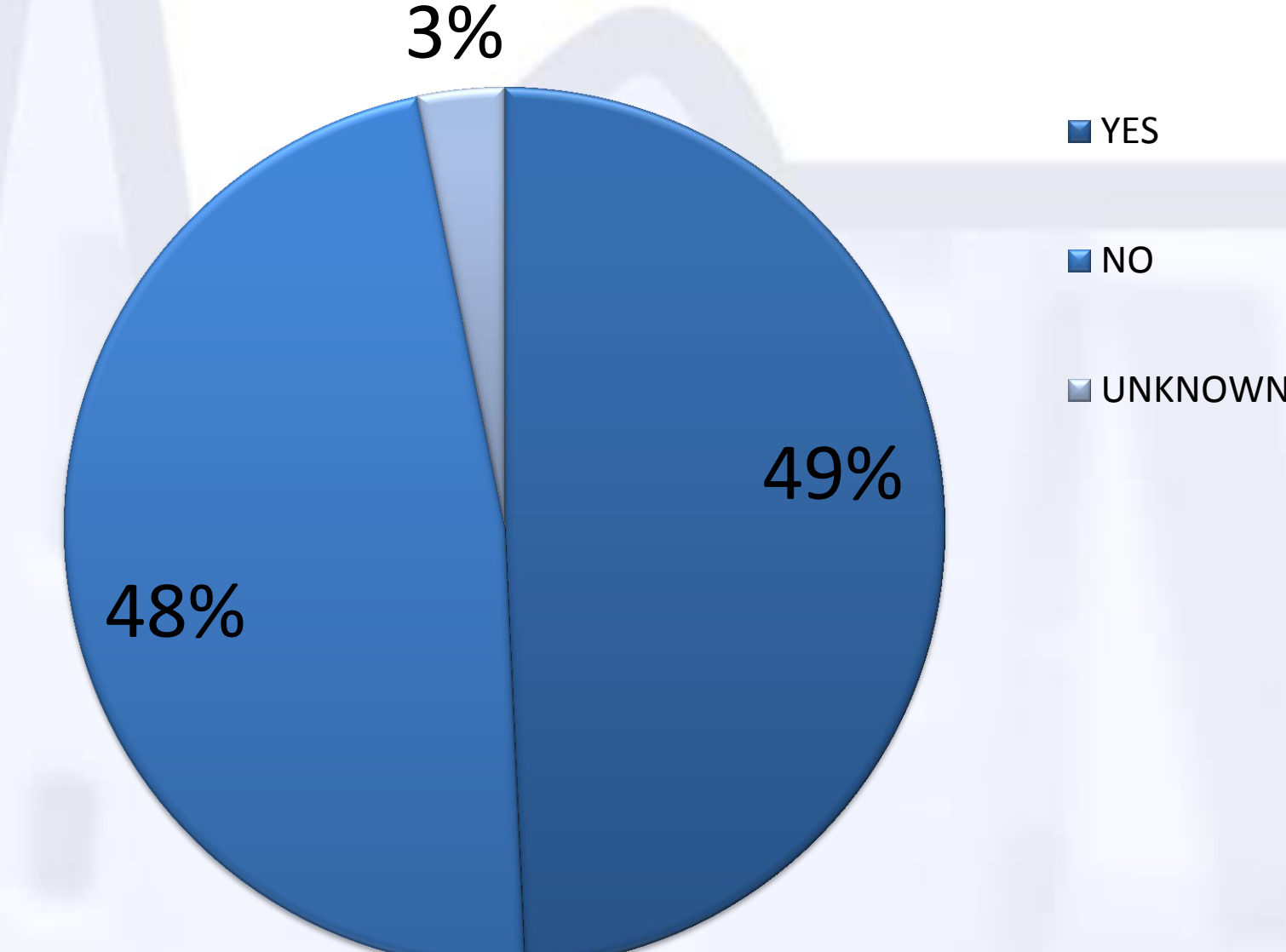
