



Madrid is constructing a 75-kilometre green ring (Bosque Metropolitano), with nearly million and a half new trees. This Urban Forest, designed to restore the soil and its ecosystems, will contribute to the rebalancing of the city, the reduction of CO₂ emissions, the fight against climate change, the ecological and landscape recovery of degraded areas and the increased supply of pedestrian and bicycle paths.




